

0-5 / Extreme Close Quarter Tactics

One of our core specialities lies in concepts at Extreme Close Quarters, ranging from 0 to 5 metres.

That is exactly the distance where traditional concepts often fail, but where most of the real-life conflicts happen. That is true for all professionals operating in urban environments, inside buildings, in vehicles and aircrafts and even for most special-operation personnel on their missions as well as regular soldiers and officers.

Of course we also teach all the classical tactical elements such as long-range shooting, driving and small-unit tactics. But in fact, typical training deals very little with close quarters, and shooting starts at 5 metres at best. Yet this does not cover the problems that have to be solved at close distances in everyday duty. What good is an officer's shooting skill at 25 metres if he gets killed by a knife-wielding man just 3 metres away?



As the first company in Europe we have made the Extreme Close Range distances into our area of expertise, and have developed this skill as our core training doctrine, because that is the distance where you will need to do your job. We call the concept "0-5" or "ZERO to FIVE".

Our concepts are innovative, modern and uncompromising. We have thought the solutions for Extreme Close Quarter Distances through to the end, and have not allowed ourselves to be misled by so-called "authorities" and doctrines.

We adopt a realistic approach and abandon training scars and so-called tactics that were the result of decades of training without much-needed controls. In fact most of what is taught today in close ranges is a result of the martial arts Dojo myth and training regulations rather than a logical analysis of reality.

One of the important foundations of "0-5" is the transfer of skills and concepts. That means, if the concept is employed for utilizing your firearm, it should transfer seamlessly to the use of the knife, the baton, flashlights, empty hands and so on.

Since the operator does not have to chance the system of usage when transitioning to another weapon or tool, it makes it much more useful under stress, much easier and quicker to learn and as such more efficient both in combat and from a financial point of view. Furthermore, our clients have found that the ability to negotiate threats at close ranges is a big booster for self confidence and combat effectiveness.

For civilian use the same principles apply as for airline cabin crews, management staff when travelling, or whoever is in need of defensive skills. Since it is very easy and quick to learn, and is effective without huge amounts of strength, it is the defensive combat of choice for a wide variety of personnel.

Our training courses in Extreme Close Quarter Shooting, Tactical Knife, Edged Weapon Awareness, Tactical Baton and other skills are among the most sought-after training courses in Europe and throughout the world. We have taught these classes to regular personnel as well as to special operations units everywhere with very good results.



Law Enforcement and Military

We are highly specialised in Extreme Close Quarters with distances ranging from 0 to 5 metres. That is exactly the distance where traditional concepts often fail, but where most of the real life- conflicts happen. As the first company in Europe we have made the Extreme Close Range distances our area of expertise, and have developed this as our core training doctrine, because that is the distance where you will need to do your job.

Think about it: How often will professionals in the security field encounter enemies beyond more than 10 metres? The vast majority of problems take place inside rooms, in rural areas, during urban warfare, counter-terrorism-warfare, at security gates, on patrol duty, and even inside cars.

What has been true for police-style work for a long time, is already a fact in military operations as well. Very rarely does anyone face an armed opponent at a distance. Yet classical techniques fail at such close ranges.

An edged weapon attack cannot be dealt with using "normal" shooting concepts. The knife attacker will always have a chance to kill or injure the officer or soldier before being shot and put out of action. Anyone who encounters firearms at ranges below 10 metres will have a serious disadvantage trying to outdraw the attacker. Instead it is paramount to know how to move and shoot as well as using non-classical concepts with the gun.

Another often-overlooked fact is the need to escalate and de-escalate within the continuum of force and to adapt one's response to the level of force used in the attack. That is especially important for security forces, law enforcement officers and also for military personnel once there is a need to capture and question the adversary.

Our training in Extreme Close Quarter Shooting, Tactical Knife, Edged Weapon Awareness, Tactical Baton and others are among the most sought-after training courses internationally.

Topics that might be of interest for you:

Extreme Close Quarter Shooting will teach you the use of firearms (from pistols to submachine guns as well as rifles) at very close ranges and in confined spaces. The integrated ECQ-Shooting concepts provide effective solutions between 0-5 metres, against both armed (blade, firearm, impact weapon) as well as unarmed adversaries.

Tactical Knife teaches the usage of bladed weapons for combat. This can be the tactical fighting knife for the soldier who finds himself cornered or pinned down, experiences a weapon malfunction or for other reasons. It also could be an officer or member of a personnel protection detail, in a situation where it is not possible to fire a gun due to the presence of innocent bystanders, tactical advantage or hazardous material. Ending up on the ground is another scenario where edged weapons give you the upper hand again to fight your way back up to your feet and transition to a firearm from there.

Edged Weapon Awareness deals with knife-wielding attackers. Blades are extremely dangerous at close ranges. Just shooting will never get you a chance to survive. In fact, within 5-7 metres, an attacker with a knife can kill a soldier or officer. That lesson teaches you to deal with blades, create a time window to transition to your primary weapon and negotiate the threat.

Tactical Baton: This course will change the way you use the baton. While classical baton training deals with striking to make persons comply, this course will show you how to fight effectively with the baton. It will teach you to deal with attacks, using the baton in closed and confined spaces. You will train how to apply takedowns that really work on the streets, and teach the interface of baton to other use of force tools and weapons. There are many other interesting topics available, as well as special programmes tailored to your specific needs.



Anti- Terrorism Education



Anti-Terrorism Consulting

In a global economy, not only government institutions but especially companies are the main targets of terrorist attacks and organised violence.

This could be because of the symbolic as well as the strategic value of the target. Big or otherwise symbolic companies, critical asset facilities or sensitive infrastructure in particular are prone to terrorist activities.

The consequences of a terrorist attack are huge. The primary loss in the first few minutes (loss of life, damage to property) is followed by secondary effects with often long-term impact (breakdown of infrastructure, loss of production, environmental disaster), as well as financial loss and damaged image.

Potential targets often are only protected against simple classical attacks like vandalism, espionage or theft.

Protection against terrorism and organised violence requires special skills in terrorism-related risk management and is much more complex than traditional security. In addition to classic approaches, overall anti-terrorism planning consists of concepts regarding operative security, protective counter-intelligence, strategic threat assessment, and post-incident procedures.

We at LAHNER ACADEMY see terrorism as a source of risk in a risk-management process. A threat assessment, vulnerability assessment and special analytical tools lead to the development of a security concept that allows for specifics and the needs of the individual company.

We strongly believe that the most valuable tool to prevent attacks is sound education of the personnel at the very front line. If guards at the gate, the officer on the street and the secretary know what to look for, they can detect signs of an imminent threat very early.

Educating all personnel involved at the frontline greatly reduces the risk.

Aviation: Inflight and Cabin Security - Human factors as the most valuable tool

Aviation security is a highly discussed topic that is widely and frequently talked about in the media, the public and politics alike.

The psychological impact of attacking an aircraft is so huge that it will always be a target for terrorism and disturbed persons alike. The financial loss in case of an event is huge, due to the multitude of factors, including loss of aircraft, payment to passengers and their families, loss of faith in the airline and reduction in transport figures.

Even statistics by the TSA itself show that ground procedures will never be able to prevent attacks. The sad truth is that even at major airports with a maximum investment in security technology and screening, testers were able to board planes with dangerous goods, weapons and explosives in up to 80% of cases.

While one cannot abandon ground procedures, it is clear that the very last line of defence that will always be in place will be the cabin crew on board. So it makes sense to train them.

Terrorism aside, there is another much more common problem with unruly passengers that could potentially be a threat to the crew, the other passengers and the aircraft alike.

Dealing with unruly and dangerous passengers in the confined spaces of an aircraft is difficult. Furthermore, the flight attendants are usually neither able-bodied nor combat-minded and therefore able to deal with the problem accordingly.

While analysing security programmes we sadly discovered that obsolete teaching schemes prevent catching up with today's threat situations and reality. So we have developed an innovative and reality-based concept that is easy to learn and really works.

We offer a broad range of options to maximise security in-flight. Our concepts for cabin crew are the latest and furthermore we make sure crew members have all the tools they need to deal with a broad range of potentially dangerous situations inflight. 
Children




For example, even trained martial artists will never be able to block a combination of punches in real time. This means that even blocking and defence concepts need to be retrained or at least modified.




